- 4. A stamped self-addressed envelope.
- 5. The appropriate check-\$10 for a nonprofit or \$20 for a business made payable to NYS Education Department.
- 6. The completed consent form.
- 7. Please confirm with the Department of State whether a corporate indicator (ie. "Inc.") needs to be included within the corporate name.
